What is an Arctic Academy Day?

-The Arctic Academy is designed for the purpose that students can continue to learn while at home through provided curriculum. Students are expected to participate in the Arctic Academy by completing all provided assignments.

-On an Arctic Academy day, students in grades 3-12 will complete assignments designed by Monongalia County educators that have been preloaded to their student Chromebooks. These assignments do not require internet for completion.

Arctic Academy Expectations

-Lessons will be approximately 40 minutes per class period (all classes the student is enrolled in on the day of Arctic Academy). For example, if the last day of school being in session is an even day, then on the Arctic Academy Day the students will follow their odd day schedule. When students return to school, the students will attend odd day classes.

-All Arctic Academy Day assignments will be considered review work and completed independently by the student.

-All assignments must be turned in within two class periods/four days of school being back in session. Any assignments turned in after the allotted days will be marked as missing.

-IEP and SAT accommodations will be addressed by the teachers

Lesson format

-Teachers will model for students how to access and submit their Arctic Academy assignments.

-While in school, teachers will instruct students how to download and access Arctic Academy lessons offline. Teachers will also communicate to students how they are expecting the work to be turned in.

Communication

-Our county School Messenger call/text will indicate that the day will be used for Arctic Academy.

-Teachers will report to school and will respond to emails, Engrade messages, or Google Classroom requests to provide support for students during school hours.

-Due to the teachers' Arctic Academy schedule, it may not be possible for immediate contact. To ensure contact, students should make prior arrangements with their teachers regarding the form of communication that the teacher wishes to use that day. Special circumstances and requests will be taken into consideration.

Arctic Academy Attendance

-Attendance will be based upon the completion of Arctic Academy assignments and time spent completing them through provided Chromebooks. Monongalia County Schools recognizes the importance of the home and school connection and strongly encourages parents to become aware of and support Arctic Academy curriculum. This support is an essential ingredient of a student's success.
