Re: Required 12th Grade Immunizations, HealthCheck and Dental Exams

Beginning with the 2012-2013 school year, all West Virginia students entering 7th grade must have had one dose of the Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis) and one dose of the meningococcal vaccine. Students entering 12th grade must also have had at least one dose of the Tdap vaccine and a second dose of the meningococcal vaccine. If the first dose of the meningococcal vaccine was received after age 16, then only one dose of this vaccine is required.

Your child's School Nurse has reviewed the immunization records that are on file with Monongalia County Schools and these records indicate your child will need the following immunizations to attend school in August 2018:

If your child has already received these vaccinations, please provide documentation to your School Nurse as soon as possible. If your child has not yet received these vaccines, please make an appointment with your primary physician as soon as possible. Please provide documentation of receiving the vaccines to your School Nurse as soon as the vaccination is administered. Students who do not have a primary physician may contact the Monongalia County Health Department to make an appointment to receive the required vaccines 304-598-5100.

Required 12th Grade HealthCheck and Dental Exams

In an endeavor to make a "best effort" to ensure all students in WV schools have a medical and dental home the Health Promotion and Disease Prevention Policy (WVBE Policy 2423) has been set into place.

Twelfth grade students are being asked to provide a completed and current (with in the last 12 months) HealthCheck and dental form at the beginning of the 2018-2019 school year.

Students may bring their HealthCheck and dental forms on the first day of school or before the 2017-18 school year ends.

State Board Policy 2423-Health Promotion and Disease Prevention, Section 5 requires HealthCheck screenings and dental exam within a "phase-in" plan from 2015/16 to 2018/19 for the following:
