STUDENT REMINDERS

- All students must bring their fully charged Chromebooks to campus every day. Students may use backpacks on campus.
- All persons entering the Morgantown High School campus must have a face covering on at all times. Please plan accordingly.
- Our campus opens for students at 7:05 am. All students must be in their First Block classes (1st or 2nd period) by 7:25 am. Morgantown High School runs a modified block schedule. OCTOBER 13, 2021 INFORMATION

Grade 9 students will be taking the PSAT 8/9 exam. Students do not need to register for the exam as Monongalia County Schools is offering this exam free of charge.

Grades 10 and 11 will be taking the PSAT-NMSQT exam. Students do not need to register for the exam as Monongalia County Schools is offering this exam free of charge.

Seniors who attend MTEC (or those who are notified to report to MTEC) will report to MTEC to complete their NOCTI benchmarking exam no later than 7:30 am.

All other Seniors will be learning remotely and will not report to school. Asynchronous lessons will be uploaded to the Morgantown High School website for students to complete prior to October 13, 2021.

Additional information for Grades 9 - 11 Students

- Students should bring an approved calculator and 2 wooden #2 pencils. We will have extras in each testing location.
- Students will be served lunch. Students may bring their own lunch. There is no eating or drinking in the testing locations.
- October 13, 2021 is a 2-Hour Early Dismissal Schedule day for High Schools ONLY!
- Buses will run on normal schedules.
- All students are asked to leave all technology (Phones, Smartwatches, Chromebooks, etc) at home during this school day. They will not need it for testing.
- More information about testing, including how to opt your student out of the exam, can be found on the PSAT-NMSQT link found under the Student Tab on the MHS website or on the banner of the MHS website. If you are opting your student out, they must complete this process by Monday, October 4th.
